### **Oak Island Publishes Final Debris Removal Schedule for Hurricane Isaias**

Last contracted debris pickup scheduled for Monday, Town to resume normal operations October 1

(Oak Island, NC) – Following the impacts of **Hurricane Isaias** on August 10, 2020, the Town of Oak Island had been contracting debris removal services through an outside vendor. The last scheduled pick up date for removal of Construction and Debris (C&D) materials is scheduled for **Monday, September 21, 2020**.

Final pick up of all items, including vegetative debris (limbs, leaves, yard waste, etc.) will be on Wednesday, September 23, 2020. No C&D materials will be collected after September 23.

**PUBLIC WORKS:** The Oak Island Public Works Department will resume normal collection operations on **Thursday, October 1, 2020**. Collection operations will begin with the **Zone 3 Collection Area**, which runs from SE 41<sup>st</sup> – NE 79<sup>th</sup> streets.

**ACCEPTED MATERIALS:** Please note that blocks, brick, and concrete will not be collected by either the contracted vendor or Public Works Department. Removal of these materials are the responsibility of the property owner. Please do not mix these materials with other debris to be collected; as doing so would only slow the removal process for all other residents.

**COLLECTION SITE:** Additionally on October 1, the Recycling Collection Site, located at 4110 Airport Road will again be available to all Town residents and owners of non-commercial property. The site will operate on its normal hours of operation, which are as follows:

- Wednesdays: 1:00 PM - 4:30 PM
- Fridays: 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM
- First Saturday of the Month: 9:00 AM – 1:00 PM
