General Statement of Duties

Employees in this class perform manual labor involving the maintenance of golf courses, beaches, beach access areas, ball fields, operation of sprinklers and the maintenance of park grounds and facilities, and related tasks. Employees work in teams or alone in landscape maintenance activities. Employees are subject to the hazards including working in outside environments, in extreme hot and cold weather, and exposure to noise, vibration, moving mechanical parts, atmospheric conditions, oils, and skin irritants. Work around raw sewerage is also subject to the final standards of OSHA on blood borne pathogens. Work is performed under regular supervision and work is evaluated by observation to determine the effectiveness of completed duties.

Distinguishing Features of the Class

An employee in this class performs manual labor involving the maintenance of park grounds and facilities and related tasks. Employees work in teams or alone in landscape maintenance activities.
