REVIEW: Christmas By The Sea Weekend

The holiday spirit is officially here in Oak Island, following the amazingly successful Christmas kickoff events of this past weekend.

Starting with the ***Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony*** on Friday night, Saturday's cloudy weather was lit up even more by the smiling faces of all participants in ***Christmas By The Sea Parade***. 2023 marked the first year of the Parade being fully coordinated by Town Staff & Volunteers. Despite the damp weather, the vent brought a record turnout, with nearly 90 entries and well over 100 individual floats, vehicles, carts, or walking groups. Finally the weekend closed out with ***9th Annual Holiday Craft Market***, which also featured a record number of vendors filling up the entire sports fields within the Middleton Park Complex.

Oak Island Honor Flags Program

During their regular meeting in November, the Town Council gave final approval for the ***Oak Island Honor Flags Program***.

The program is an authorized personalization of the ***Hometown Heroes Banner*** initiative, which started in Harrisburg, PA in 2006, and seeks to honor members of the Armed Forces and their families through banners mounted on freestanding poles throughout Town.

The program is open to all fallen, retired, and active members of all branches of the military, and costs \$70.00 for a 2.5' wide x 8' tall banner (flag). The flags will be installed in the Middleton Park Complex during the long weekends of Memorial Day, July 4th, and Labor Day; as well as in Veterans Park on September 11 and Veterans Day.

Throughout the month of November, these iconic boxes have been collecting gifts for little ones in need this holiday season. However, **there is now only ONE WEEK left to make your donations**, as the boxes will be removed at the end of the day next **Tuesday, November 12**.

Collection boxes are currently located in Town Hall, the Police Department, Recreation Center, the Oak Island Pier House, and ALL three (3) Fire Stations.

UPDATE: Work Begins on Davis Canal Pedestrian Walkover

This past Monday (November 27), the **Davis Canal Pedestrian Walkover** which connects **SE 20th Street** and **19th Place East** was **CLOSED** to allow for equipment staging in the upcoming repair project.

Beginning today (December 4) demolition work will begin on the project.

As a reminder, this work will replace the arched northern section of the walkway, closest to SE 20th Street which was not part of the repairs in 2021 following Hurricane Isaias. That southern portion of the walkway may still be open at times for walking and nature viewing, but ***thru-traffic to SE 20th Street will not be available until further notice.***

NOTE: This is an **active construction site**, so please **DO NOT** try to enter the area or slow down crews by trying to speak with them about project updates.

Once the demolition has been completed and further evaluations have been made, an estimated time for replacement will be added to the **Projects & Facility Closures** page of the Town Website, which can be viewed at www.OakIslandNC.gov/PROJECTS or by clicking the link below.

RECAP: Paid Parking Special Meeting

On **Tuesday, November 28**, the Town Council held a Special Meeting, for the purpose of receiving public feedback on the **2023 Paid Parking Program**; and consideration of potential changes to the Paid Parking Program for the 2024 season.

Lasting about 40 minutes, the Town Council heard from nine (9) individuals who signed up to provide public comments. Councilmembers then provided their own observations to consider, before agreeing to come back for a final meeting where decisions for the 2024 Season will be made.

NOTICE: A Special Meeting to determine program guidelines for the **2024 Paid Parking Season** is tentatively scheduled for **Tuesday, December 19, 2023** at **3:00 PM** in the Council Chambers. Once confirmed a notification email will be sent out through the **OKInformation** system.

The ceremony will include opening statements and playing of ***Taps***, which will then be followed by a moment of silence. As always the event will conclude with those present facing (or saluting) due West, towards Hawaii, and casting roses into the sea. **This is a free public event that is open to all, and provides a good educational opportunity for school aged children or homeschool group**
