

Town Council Letter on Proposed Insurance Rates

This past **Thursday, February 1**, Mayor Elizabeth White sent a letter on behalf of the Oak Island Town Council to **North Carolina Insurance Commissioner Mike Causey**, expressing the Council's concerns regarding the North Carolina Rate Bureau's proposed 2024 homeowner insurance rate increases.

This letter joins in opposition expressed by the Brunswick County Commissioners and several neighboring coastal communities. It was submitted prior to the February 2 closing of the public comment period, set by the N.C. Department of Insurance.

Under North Carolina law, the Insurance Commissioner has 50 days from the filing date to review the Rate Bureau's proposal to determine whether it meets certain very technical, mathematical standards. After this 50-day review period, which expires on February 22, the Commissioner can hold a hearing. Commissioner Causey has called for such hearing, which has been set for **Monday, April 8, 2024, at 10:00 AM** at the NC Department of Insurance, located at 3200 Beechleaf Court in Raleigh.

Season Parking Permits Sales Open

On **Saturday, February 3**, the sale of **Season Parking Permits** opened up for the **2024 Paid Parking Season**. After some reported slowdowns from the initial rush to the website, contracted vendor Otto Connect reported a strong first day of sales, reaching **888 Season Permits** on Saturday alone.

As of NOON today (February 5), Season Permit sales were at 1,100, with just a few hundred left available before reaching the season total of 1,500 set by the Town Council for 2024.

As a reminder, **Season Parking Permits** are for **anyone** to purchase, and should not be confused with **Town Parking Permits**, which are available exclusively to **residents and property owners**.

Live Oaks Planted on Oak Island Drive

If you took a stroll last week down Oak Island Drive, you probably noticed something new ... **TREES!** More specifically, **live oak trees lining the right-of-way**.

Last **Wednesday, January 31**, hard-working crews from the Public Works Department (*pictured HERE, and in the GALLERY*) planted over **forty-five** live oaks (*Quercus Virginiana*) along the town's main thoroughfare. The trees were purchased as part of a capital improvement project budgeted in the **Stormwater Department** for this current fiscal year.

"Our crews did a wonderful job planting these beautiful trees" noted Stormwater Administrator Rick Patterson, "The live oaks planted today will help restore tree canopy lost from development while supplying shade and helping to absorb stormwater in the future."

With a potential lifespan of well over 300 years, Patterson is correct, as these trees could ultimately produce a canopy - 100 foot spread. Once reaching a diameter of 15" these "Heritage Trees," will forever be protected by Town ordinance. 60
