## THIS WEEK: Town Manager Recruitment Public Input Sessions

Announced earlier this month in a ***letter from Mayor Liz White***, the Town Council has invited the public to participate in the recruitment process for a new Town Manager, through a series of ***Public Input Sessions*** to be held **THIS WEEK**.

The sessions will be held in the Council Chambers, located on the second floor of Town Hall on **Wednesday, February 28 at 10:00 AM, 2:00 PM, & 6:00 PM** and on **Saturday, March 2 a 10:00 AM & 1:00 PM**.

These will be a guided exercise of specific questions, ***and will not be a formal meeting of the full Council***. Seating for each session will be limited to 80 participants, so plan to arrive early.

## Re-Advertisement Notice: Paving Contract RFP

***Due to an insufficient number of bids, this Request for Proposals is being re-advertised and will now close on Wednesday, March 6, 2024 at 10:00 AM.***

The Town of Oak Island is seeking proposals from qualified, professional service contractors for paving and resurfacing of existing streets for the Town. The work will entail street resurfacing and associated work.

The selected contractor will commence and complete the construction of Town of Oak Island street improvements consisting of paving and resurfacing of streets as outlined on the Bid Schedules submitted. The contractor may submit recommendations for changes to the specifications and / or planned work; any such changes, including increased cost thereof, if applicable, shall be pre-approved by the Public Works Director.

The Town will evaluate the bids based on the sum of the “Total Bid” for the projects. The Town reserves the right to reject any or all of the project bids or bidders. There will be no Pre-Bid meeting. Bids will be opened next **Wednesday, March 6 at 10:00 AM** in the second floor conference room of the Oak Island Town Hall, located at 4601 East Oak Island Drive.

## Army Corps of Engineers Meeting Review

This past **Wednesday, February 21**, the **U.S. Army Corps of Engineers** (USACE) held a Public Input Session regarding the proposed ***Coastal Storm Risk Management 50-Year Study***.

Although not sponsored or coordinated by the Town, the meeting was hosted in the Town Council Chambers at Town Hall, and was open to the public for both in-person and online participation.

The meeting offered a brief overview of the 50-year Coastal Storm Risk Management (CSRM) plan for the Town of Oak Island, which aims to explore various risk management alternatives, from taking no action to structural measures such as beach nourishment. Following the presentation a brief period for questions and discussion was held.

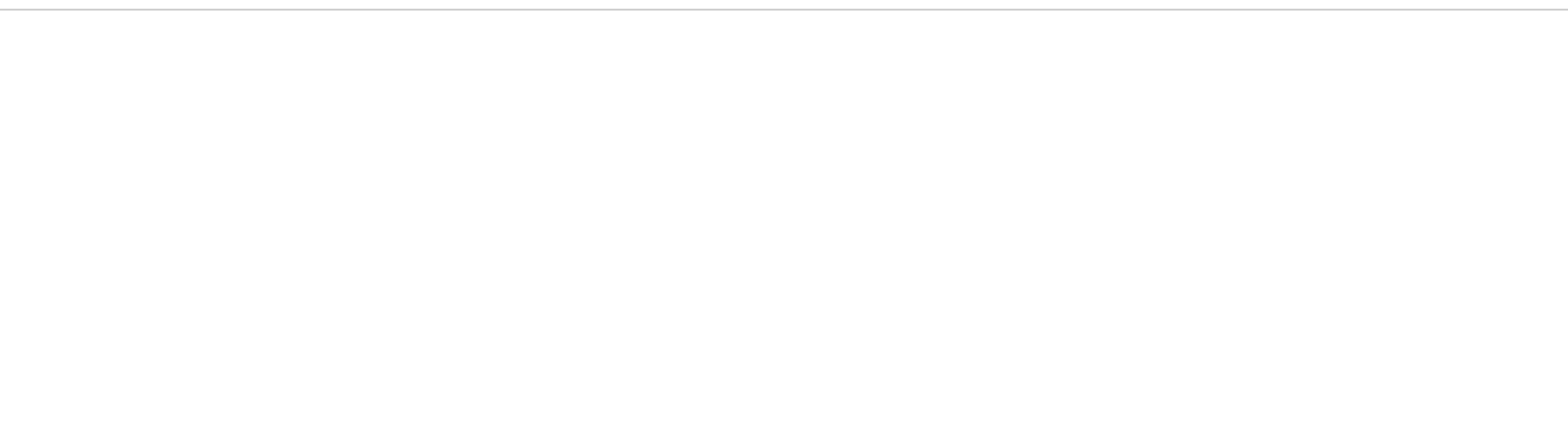
## Community Center Calendar Updated for March

This past week, NNO presented the Oak Island Police Department with their prestigious ***Rookie of the Year*** Award. This award is presented to the agency making the best "first impression" in their efforts to participate in "*America's Night out Against Crime*."

## FIRE DEPARTMENT: "High 5" Makes Debut

If you attended the **Mardi Gras By the Sea Parade** this weekend, you might have seen the latest addition to our arsenal at the Oak Island Fire Department, a "new-to-us" 5-ton **High Water Vehicle** we've aptly named "***High 5***."

**Pictured HERE** during Saturday's parade, the **1986 AM General M939** is a 6-wheel drive beast originally designed to transport 10,000 lbs (4,500 kg) of payload over the most challenging of terrain, in the most punishing weather.

For use in Oak Island, ***High 5*** will be placed in service as a High-Water Rescue & Support vehicle, making good use of its extreme ground clearance. It will be housed at Station 2 and be available for emergency calls involving high water or any other conditions which would be impassable to normal response vehicles. As of this past weekend, High 5 is officially in service, and will be operated by a combination of members from the Fire Department and Police Department.
