

Oak Island Pier Closure

On **Tuesday, April 2, 2024** the [Oak Island Pier](#) will be **CLOSED** for the **ENTIRE DAY**.

[NOTE: This is an update to the previous release which stated the Pier would close early at Noon.]

This closure is to accommodate filming by the television company **Beachfront Productions, LLC**, who will be working from **NOON** to **MIDNIGHT** that day to film an episode of the HGTV series "**Battle On the Beach**." The Pier House, Restaurant, and Coffee Shop within the Pier Complex will also remain **OPEN**.

PLEASE NOTE: This filming will include a brief fireworks display off the Pier that evening, so explosive sounds may be heard in the area.

Paid Parking Season Underway

As of **Monday, April 1, 2024** the **Paid Parking** program is now in effect for the 2024 season. As a reminder, during the season, enforcement of Paid Parking spaces will be from **April 1 - September 30**, between the hours of **9:00 AM - 5:00 PM**.

Throughout the season as new visitors arrive each week, questions will pop up frequently from new users. Remember that **YOU** can answer these questions, relieve confusion, and stop the spread of misinformation, all by offering a simple website link! If you see someone in person or online with questions about Paid Parking, simply refer them to the **Parking Information** page of the Town Website. This is the **ONLY official source** of program information from the Town, and is updated regularly with any program developments as needed.

Beach Safety Review

In addition to the Paid Parking program, **Monday April 1** also marks the start of the **Beach Warning Flag** forecasts from the **National Weather Service (NWS)**. In addition to the physical flags that will be flown (*see the Safety Brief below for more details*), the forecasts are also available on the Town Website.

For 2024, the Town is **doubling** the number of pages where this information can be found, which now include the:

FIRE DEPARTMENT: Warning Flags Now Flying

As mentioned earlier, April 1 marks the start of Beach warning Flag forecasts in Oak Island. At this point, most everybody knows you can find the current Flag Condition on the Town Website, but we are often asked ***where are the flags physically flown at?***

Over the past few years, the Town has made significant strides in expanding the visibility and number of locations where we fly the daily forecast flags.

These include:

- **Mounted on ALL of the Fire Department vehicles**
- **Fire Stations 1 (101 E Oak Island Drive)**

- **Fire Stations 2 (8510 E Oak Island Drive)**
- **The Oak Island Water Rescue Station (4901 E Pelican Drive)**
- **On the flagpole of Crossroads Gathering Place, at the base of the GV Barbee bridge**
- **Mounted on the utility vehicles of the Beach Services Unit during all active patrols**

Event with all of these locations (many of which are mobile) and the signage on the Water Safety Stations, there are always visitors who simply don't know to look out for them. **That's where you can help!** Make sure to help spread the word, and encourage your friends and neighbors to visit the ***Beach Safety Information*** page everyday for the latest information at OakIslandNC.gov/SAFETY.
