ABC BOARD will hold its next meeting (non-televised) on **Tuesday, May 14 at 10:00 AM** in the Oak Island ABC Store at 5402 E Oak Island Drive.

TOWN COUNCIL will hold its regular meeting (televised) on **Tuesday, May 14 at 6:00 PM** in the Council Chambers, located on the 2nd floor of Town Hall at 4601 E Oak Island Drive.

PLANNING BOARD will hold its next meeting (televised) on **Thursday, May 16 at 9:00 AM** in the Council Chambers located on the 2nd floor of Town Hall.

Town Council Meeting Preview

The Town Council will hold their regular monthly meeting on **Tuesday, May 14, at 6:00 PM** in the Town Council Chambers.

The Meeting Agenda includes **THREE (3) Public Hearings** to receive citizens' comments on the following:

- **HEARING 1:** Sign Regulations, to permit two 300 square foot electronic signs at a height of 35 feet in the Airport Zoning district or within 600 feet of the district.
- **HEARING 2:** Sign Regulations, to reduce the maximum height of Column/Pole signs to 15 feet, reduce the area of Column/Pole signs in the C-LD zoning district to 150 square feet, and create a Highway Overlay District to regulate off-premises signage.

- **HEARING 3:** Zoning Map Amendment, to apply the Highway Overlay District in a 400' wide corridor along NC 211 and Middleton Ave in the Town's zoning jurisdiction.

The meeting will also contain THREE (3) **Presentations** on:

- **Proposed FY 2024-2025 Budget**, presented by Town Staff.
- The **Recycling Program**, presented by contracted service provider Green For Life, with Sonoco available to answer questions.
- the **Ocean Rescue Unit**, presented by the Oak Island Fire Department

Public Comments, Council Reports, and Staff Reports will come next followed by the Consent Agenda and TWO (2) **Old Business** items, which include:

- Discussion of Recommendations from the Planning Board's review of the Table of Uses, Supplemental Regulations, and Definitions.
- Consideration of Reissuing a Request for Proposals to be Issued for Professional Engineering Services / Parking Assessment.

There are FOUR (4) **New Business** items, which include:

- Consideration of Action to Direct the Planning Board to Review Section 2.15, Height Limit Exceptions.
- Consideration of Annual Agreement with Oak Island Water Rescue.
- Consideration of Lease for Oak Island Water Rescue Property.
- Consideration of Budget Ordinance Amendment to appropriate the remaining American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds.

ELECTION NOTICE: Recreation Center Classes Cancelled

Please note, all classes at the **Oak Island Recreation Center** will be **CANCELLED** on **Tuesday, May 14, 2024**. This cancellation is to accommodate the recreation Center's use as a voting location in the **May 14 Second Primary**.

There has been a request for a second primary in two statewide contests: Republican Lieutenant Governor and Republican State Auditor. If no candidate in a primary receives more than 30% of the vote, the candidate who receives the second-highest vote total may demand a second primary. The top two vote-getters would be on the ballot for the second primary.

The Election Day for this Second Primary has been set for Tuesday, May 14, with polls open from **6:30 AM - 7:30 PM**.

REMINDER: Summer Collection Schedule Underway

This past Saturday, May 11 the **Garbage & Recycling Collection Summer Schedule** began for **Collection Zones 6, 7, & 8**. this change means that Garbage Collection service is now being provided every Wednesday & Saturday, with Recycling Collection provided every Saturday. Collection will switch back to the normal schedule on September 28

As a reminder, ZONE 6 is the area of East Beach Dr., East Dolphin Dr., & East Pelican Dr. (from Middleton Ave. - 58th St.), ZONE 7 is the area of East Beach Dr. (from SE 69th St. - 79th St.), & Ocean Dr., and ZONE 8 is the area of West Beach Dr., West Dolphin Dr., West Pelican Drive, & Kings Lynn Dr.

Oak Island has *eight (8) **Garbage & Recycling Collection Zones*** throughout Town. While most of the year these areas are provided collection service on one day per week, during the Summer the more heavily visited trafficked areas of Zones 6, 7, & 8 switch to a two times per week collection. Computer Recycling Event

On **Saturday, June 1, 2024**, from **10:00 AM - 2:00 PM**, the Town of Oak Island will host a **Computer Recycling Event** to benefit the **Brunswick County Computers 4 Kids** (BCC4K) program. Equipment can be dropped off in the parking lot behind the Oak Island Police Department at 4621 E Oak Island Drive.

BCC4K is a non-profit organization which refurbishes used computers, for use by Brunswick County School students in need of a home computer. Since its inception in 2006, BCC4K has refurbished and donated over **4,400 systems**. Forms for tax deduction will be available.

Systems **DO NOT** need to working in order to donate, and ALL data will be wiped from hard drives to ensure protection of personal information. **Apple** products will need to be **reset to original settings** and **removed from Apple accounts**.

In the weeks and months since, that video and the call which inspired it created a huge amount of public interest. This led community partners **Stop Loss LLC.** and **Better Beach Rentals** to come back with an even *LARGER* donation, not only of specially assistive smoke alarms, but also Carbon Monoxide and regular smoke detectors as well.

This past **Friday, May 10**, we were honored to receive these donations at Station 2, where they were delivered and presented to Chief Price and our Administrative Staff.

Over the past couple of weeks especially, it is has been truly encouraging to see the amount of care members of our community have for one another; not only after tragedies strike, but as in this case, with helping to prevent them as well.

POLICE DEPARTMENT: BSU Season Launches

Last week, we wrapped up training for the **Beach Services Unit (BSU)** ahead of their 2024 Season. As pictured in this week's cover photo, staff members were trained in **driving on the beach** using the Department's THREE (3) **brand new UTVs** purchased for 2024. Staff also finished their **in-class training** as well.

Now that they have completed this, we are excited to announce that **Beach Services Unit** patrols will **begin this Thursday, May 16 at 7:00 AM.**

Building upon the successes of the previous two seasons, for 2024 the BSU will consist of THREE (3) teams, patrolling in staggered shifts of:

- **7:00 AM - 3:00 PM**
- **9:00 AM - 5:00 PM**
- **10:00 AM - 6:00 PM**

Started in 2022, the Beach Service Unit (BSU) is a civilian-staffed branch of the Oak Island Police Department, which works to preserve and maintain the public beach areas within the Town of Oak Island. Members of the BSU do not carry firearms or conduct police tasks, but are authorized to issue citations for violating Town ordinances related to dunes, beach safety, and parking. All BSU members wear specific uniforms, with *BEACH SERVICES* prominently displayed across the back of their shirt, and make their patrols in the blue, department-marked utility vehicles (UTVs) pictured in the links above. Aerial drone video is also used to monitor surf conditions in real time, and record ordinance violations.
