Land Use Plan Update: New Committee

REMINDER: The deadline to submit applications for the Steering Committee and for the Stakeholders Groups is **NOON on Wednesday, July 31, 2024**.

The Town of Oak Island is actively involved in the process of updating the Comprehensive Land Use Plan, and there are **several ways you can participate!**

There will be a **Steering Committee** which will meet several times throughout the update process (meeting schedule to be determined), with a recommended makeup including two Council members, two Planning Board members, one member each from the Business Advisory Board, the Environmental Advisory Committee, and the Recreation Advisory Board. Council will also consider applications for two additional at-large members.

A **Stakeholders Group** will also be an option for those wanting to be involved but needing less of a time commitment. Each stakeholder group will meet with the consultant for approximately one hour (*meeting date and time to be determined*)

NEW Par 3 Golf "Dot Com" URL

Oak Island Par 3 Golf is one of the best par three courses in the region. Located 30 minutes south of Wilmington, NC and less than an hour north of Myrtle Beach, SC, this exciting course is adjacent to the Cape Fear Jetport, in the serene South Harbour community, on the mainland section of Town.

The course is designed with a layout that all levels of golfers can play and enjoy, whether playing with family, friends, or children, golf experiences here will be both challenging and fun. Throughout the past few years, the course has seen a significant revitalization. With staff pouring countless hours into the aesthetics and playability, the course has increased its status as a "commercially marketable" asset for the Town.

This is being reflected in the NEW website domain for the Oak Island Par 3, launched just this week at www.OKIpar3.com.

Although the Par 3's website will remain on the Town's "dot gov" domain, the new "dot com" commercial URL is more appropriate for marketing the course independently of the Town, and attracting even more players.

FIRE: "Meet With The Chief" Success

On **Friday, July 19**, Chief Lee Price held the first ever "**MEET With The CHIEF**" Public Availability Session in the Town Council Chambers at Town Hall. This presentation and informal discussion provided a chance for residents to ask questions, correct misinformation, and learn valuable fire prevention information.



The session proved a tremendous success, with nearly **60 people in attendance**. Real topics of concern were discussed, and real examples of misinformation were addressed. The session was broadcast LIVE on OKI-TV (Spectrum Cable channel 8) and made available immediately afterwards on the **Fire Prevention** page of the Town Website.
