Swimming Advisory Lifted

On **Saturday, July 27**, State officials lifted a **Precautionary Swimming Advisory**, which had been issued a day earlier for the beach area near Crowell St., where floodwater pumping had occurred.

Water quality in the surf areas along Oak Island are regularly tested as part of the **NC Recreational Water Quality Program**, administered by the **Department of Environmental Quality** (NCDEQ).

The program conducts testing at 11 sites in the Town of Oak Island, and two in neighboring Caswell Beach, for *enterococcus bacteria*. This is an "indicator organism" that does not cause illness, but is an indicator of of organisms that can.

NEW Garbage & Recycling Cart Replacement Form

DID YOU KNOW the Town of Oak Island has over **11,000 homes**? Each one of those homes has at least one **Garbage & Recycling Cart** ... and some have more. That's around **25,000 carts** collected **every seven (7) days**, just from residential use alone!

With so many carts getting collected, things are bound to break, get worn out, or sometimes even "wander off" (*seriously, DON'T forget to bring your empty carts back in before a storm hits!*)

To help streamline the process of requesting a replacement cart, the Public Works Department has launched the new **Garbage & Recycling Cart Request / Replacement Form**.

The new form provides easy one-click options to request a removal broken carts and replacement of missing carts, for both residential and short-term rental properties.

There will be a **Steering Committee** which will meet several times throughout the update process (meeting schedule to be determined), with a recommended makeup including two Council members, two Planning Board members, one member each from the Business Advisory Board, the Environmental Advisory Committee, and the Recreation Advisory Board. Council will also consider applications for two additional at-large members.

A **Stakeholders Group** will also be an option for those wanting to be involved but needing less of a time commitment. Each stakeholder group will meet with the consultant for approximately one hour (*meeting date and time to be determined*)
