



## TOWN OF OAK ISLAND DECLARATION OF STATE OF EMERGENCY

DATE: August 6, 2024

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Body of the Town of Oak Island, North Carolina, has duly adopted an ordinance authorizing the Mayor to determine and proclaim the existence of a State of Emergency and to impose various restrictions after it is determined that such restrictions are necessary as a response to an emergency.

**NOW THEREFORE, I, S. ELIZABETH WHITE, MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF OAK ISLAND, NORTH CAROLINA DO HEREBY PROCLAIM:**

That an emergency exists, and this Declaration is necessary in order to maintain an acceptable level of public order, services, and protection of lives, safety, and property during this emergency; and

A State of Emergency for the Town of Oak Island is hereby declared effective at 12:30 p.m., until further notice.

This Declaration is necessitated by threat to the health, safety and welfare of the community posed by Tropical Storm Debby.

A voluntary evacuation is ordered for residents and visitors effective at 12:30 p.m. August 6, 2024. There are no additional restrictions imposed.

This Declaration may be amended to include restrictions if necessary.
