
The purpose of this meeting is to hold a Closed Session, to discuss Specific Personnel pursuant to NCGS 143-318.11(a)(6). Action may be taken.

NEW Façade Improvement Grant (FIG) Program

The Town of Oak Island is committed to maintaining and improving the aesthetic appeal of its commercial districts, which are crucial to the Town's history, image, and economic vitality. To support this goal, the Town Council has approved the **Facade Improvement Grant** (FIG) Program, approved by Town Council **August 13, 2024**.

This program provides an exciting opportunity for commercial property owners and tenants in Oak Island to receive **financial assistance** for **exterior improvements** to their buildings. By participating in this program, businesses can not only enhance their own properties but also contribute to the overall revitalization and charm of Oak Island.

The FIG Program offers **matching grants that cover up to 50%** of the cost of qualifying façade improvements. Grants can range from a minimum of \$250 to a maximum of \$10,000 per project. Only one application per property will be accepted each year, and funding is limited. Awards are made on a first-come, first-served basis, subject to the availability of funds.

Walkover OPEN / Playground CLOSED

Back in March of this year, work was completed on a replacement of the arched northern end of the Davis Canal Pedestrian Walkover, which connects SE 20th Street and 19th Place East. Immediately following in late April, work began on replacing a similar arched section in the Davis Canal Pedestrian Walkover connecting SE 9th Street to 9th Place East.

Despite a couple of setbacks from scheduling and a little tropical storm named "Debby" -- work was finally completed this past week, with the walkover **REOPENED** and returned to service over the weekend. This now completes the total replacement of BOTH walkovers since sustaining damage due to Hurricane Isaias in A 2020.

As one facility opens, so another must close ... ***but only for a DAY this time!*** The ***Pirate Ship & Original Playground*** facilities in the Middleton Park Complex will both be **CLOSED** on **Tuesday, August 27** to accommodate the adding of new mulch. This is mulch specifically designed for playground areas, and will refresh what is currently installed. The closure should only take a few hours for each location, and each feature will be reopened as soon as work is complete.

FIRE: Missing Juvenile Makes for A "Teaching Moment"

This past **Wednesday, August 21 at 1:45 PM**, responders were notified of a missing juvenile in the area just east of the Oak Island Pier. The drone unit (already in the area) immediately launched, while the parent was able to visually observe the monitor and assist in finding their child within minutes.

The child had walked over **ONE MILE** west of the Pier, and was located around **SE 70th St.** Members of the **Ocean Rescue Unit** provided a ride back to the Pier in the new Utility Vehicles, recently entered into service.

While the child was NOT in immediate danger, and this call had a positive outcome, it provides a great opportunity for some important safety reminders:

1. Just like "highway hypnosis" can affect you while driving, the similar lines of the beach and sea landscape can often have you walking much farther than you might realize. this can lead to fatigue, and as in a recent missing persons case, disorientation. If going on a long walk, take frequent pauses to note your surroundings and how far you've come, and remember to save enough energy to make it back!
2. Exploring your surroundings can be fun. If ANY of your family (not just children) like to go for walks, remember to take a photo of them when heading out onto the beach, so that we'll know what they look like and what they're wearing that day, to help make locating them easier if needed.
3. Finally, remember to "make a game plan when you hit the sand." Make sure everyone knows WHEN and WHERE to meet in case they get separated or go off to do their own thing.

The beach is a fun and safe place to enjoy the beauty of nature, but like most things, it's always good to keep some general safety practices in mind.



POLICE: New "SLOW RIDE: Take It Safely" Campaign

Although it was delayed a couple of weeks (no thanks to Tropical Storm Debby), we are excited to finally launch our new **SLOW RIDE: Take It Safely** campaign for Low Speed Vehicles.

As noted in the [announcement video on our Facebook page](#), we have already increased our LSV enforcement, and have **ALL NEW Information Cards** we'll be passing out, which feature a NEW MAP on the backside that gives LSV drivers alternative routes to the heavier traffic on streets like Oak Island Dr. and Beach Dr.



Remember, LSVs are treated just like any other vehicle on the road. We respect their right to enjoy our streets as much as any other vehicle, and apply the law equally. By providing these safety reminders and helpful route suggestions, we can work together to let everyone enjoy the Island ... ***at their own pace!***
