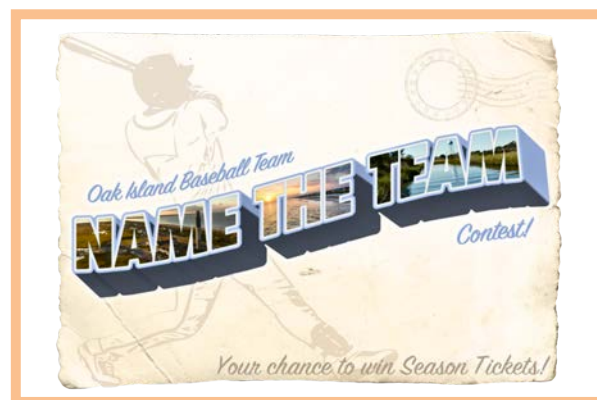

## ***PTC #8 Recovery: SBA Loans Now Available***

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) has announced that businesses and residents in Brunswick County affected by severe storms and flooding that occurred September 16–20, 2024, are eligible to apply for low-interest disaster loans from the SBA. Full details about this opportunity are now available on the Brunswick County website.

The SBA will open a Disaster Loan Outreach Center at the Town Creek Community Building, located at 6420 Ocean Hwy E, Winnabow, to assist businesses and residents in completing their disaster loan application, accept documents, and provide updates on an application's status. Walk-ins are accepted, or an in-person appointment can be scheduled at the Disaster Loan Outreach Center in advance.

## **BANDING TOGETHER: New Information Added**

Announced this past week, on **Sunday, November 3, 2024** from **NOON – 5:00 PM**, the Town of Oak Island will host "**Banding Together: Relief for Western NC**" event at the **Middleton Park Complex**.

This **four-band concert** will feature food, music, and donation collections, to benefit the region of **Spruce Pine, NC** in their ongoing recovery efforts following **Hurricane Helene** in September.



Though the devastation experienced in Western North Carolina is starting to fade from public view, ***the need for this "second phase" donation effort is more critical than ever!*** The specific supplies listed and monetary donations brought in by this event, **will greatly help this region as the colder Fall / Winter months set in.**

***Banding Together*** is being organized in direct coordination with town officials from Spruce Pine, and will focus on the items **currently needed** at this stage of the recovery process.

## **REMINDER: Brunswick Utilities Changeover to Chlorine**

(**NOTE:** This notice is provided by [Brunswick County Public Utilities](#))

Reminder that **beginning this week on October 26**, Brunswick County Public Utilities will transition to using free chlorine as the primary disinfectant, during their ***Annual Flushing Program***.

During the program, Public Utilities employees flush the water mains by opening fire hydrants and allowing them to flow freely for a short period of time. The annual change from chloramines to chlorine for this brief period is required by the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality. During the flushing, a slight change is made in the water treatment process, transitioning the disinfectant used from combined chlorine (in the form of chloramines) to chlorine in an uncombined state, commonly referred to as *free chlorine*.

# SAFETY BRIEF



## FIRE: Hydrant Testing Continues

As a reminder, our annual Fire Hydrant Testing & Maintenance program is still underway, and will continue through the month of November. While things like the weather, **County Hydrant Flushing**, and our own call volume have slowed some progress, we are still hard at work to complete this requirement of the North Carolina Department of Insurance (NCDOI).



Until completed, testing will continue each Monday - Friday from 8:00 AM – 4:00 PM.

**As a reminder:** please allow firefighters to complete the testing safely and quickly, and do not approach fire engines or try to talk with firefighters while they are testing. If there is an emergency while firefighters are in your area, **call 9-1-1 FIRST**.

The Town maintains over 830 fire hydrants. Each year, ALL of these hydrants must be inspected, with full testing performed on 20% of the hydrants. This ensures that every hydrant is inspected yearly, and goes no more than 5 years without full testing. Hydrant testing is an important aspect of maintaining readiness in response to emergency calls for assistance.

# POLICE: New Pet Microchip Scanner

As a per owner one of the most heart-wrenching experiences you can have, is the sudden realization ***you don't know where your pet is***. While we all try to be responsible pet owners, things can and do happen. Whether it's due to a loose gate, an open door or window, or simply an ambitious four-legged escape artist, pets sometimes do go on their own adventures and lose their way to get back home.

That's where we come in, as we often respond to calls of lost pets seen wandering. Thankfully we now have a new tool to help assist in such cases, through our **Proscan 700 Pet Microchip Scanner**.



With this new tool, donated by Dr. Jim Adams, we can scan lost and found pets for any microchips, which can help immediately locate their owners. This small handheld device is available to our officers on-the-go, which means the best part you don't have to do anything new! Just call 9-1-1 to report the animal as you normally would, and one of our responding officers can come to your area to help find any potential information that may be available.

We'll be evaluating the effectiveness of this tool over the coming weeks and months, with the possibility of expanding the program in the future.
