

Town Hall Renovations RFP

In addition to the training above to improve customer service for Oak Island employees, additional changes are coming for how you ACCESS those employees!

The Town of Oak Island is **inviting qualified (licensed) contractors to submit sealed bids** for furnishing labor, materials and equipment required to complete the **Town Hall Renovation Project**. This project will dramatically improve the efficiency in the layout of Town Hall, as seen in the example drawing below:



This renovation aims to enhance the accessibility and security of the building by repositioning key service areas and adding security features. The project involves moving the customer windows for Tax & Utility Collection, as well as Community Development (Permitting & Inspections) to the front lobby of the building, making these services more accessible to the public while optimizing the existing space.

All bids must be submitted by **10:00 AM on Wednesday, November 27, 2024**. Oak Island Pier on Fall Schedule

Though we've all held on as long as we could, it's no secret that Summer is long gone, and Autumn has taken over. With that, comes smaller crowds and shorter hours of daylight ... and the need to adjust schedules accordingly.

As such, the Oak Island Pier is transitioning to its **Fall Operating Schedule**. Effective immediately, the operating hours for the Pier & Pier House are **7:00 AM - 9:00 PM daily**.

Located at 705 Ocean Drive, the Oak Island Pier & Pier House remain open 7 days a week, year round. In addition to fishing passes, anglers and visitors alike will find the Pier House conveniently stocked with frozen bait, fishing tackle, sundries, snacks, ice cream, and drinks for purchase. Shirts, sunglasses and other souvenirs are also available. As always, even fans who aren't nearby can still visit the Pier anytime virtually through the ***Oak Island Pier Cam***.

SAFETY BRIEF



POLICE & FIRE: Joint Message on Halloween Safety

As noted in the intro to this week's edition, the Town has certainly had **lots of fun with our annual Spooktacular event** already, but there's still a few days left in October, and Halloween itself to go!

For events such as the Recreation Department's **Trunk-Or-Treat**, along with local neighborhood activities, we know there will be lots of tricksters out calling for treats (and adults looking to collect their "parent tax").

To help ensure a safe and fun evening for everyone, the Fire and Police departments would like to offer the following important reminders.

For PERSONAL SAFETY out trick-or-treating or attending an event:

- **Take a current picture of your child**, showing their face and costume, to assist emergency personnel in locating them if they get lost

- **Walk together in groups**, continually checking with each other to ensure everyone is watching for oncoming traffic
- **Choose costumes that are bright and reflective**, or that at least have reflective portions
Avoid costumes that have long, trailing fabric
- **Wear masks with large holes cut out**, so they do not restrict vision or breathing
- **Use actual flashlights** (not just phone lights) or glow sticks to help you see and be seen

For FIRE SAFETY with home decorations:

- **Avoid candles, torches, or decorations with a real flame** - use battery powered candles or glow sticks instead
- **Use appropriately rated electric / extension cords** and ensure they are not in wet areas
- **Don't leave decorations running all night** or when not able to be monitored
- **Keep sidewalks, pathways, and entrances clear of decorations or signage** - keep emergency exit routes open
- **Test all smoke alarms and fire extinguishers** to be sure they are in working order

Most importantly, remember ***if you see something ... say something!*** If there is an emergency, if someone gets lost, you encounter a problem, or something simply does not look right, **do not be embarrassed or afraid to call 9-1-1** for assistance. Police, Fire, and Medical first responders will be available and ready to assist as needed.
