## Road Closure Returns

Although delayed due to storm recovery needs, the **NCDOT RESTARTED** the **211 / 133 DETOUR** as part of the **NC 211 widening project** currently underway.

If you're not familiar this project will **CLOSE** the portion of Long Beach Road road near Southport-Supply Road (NC 211), and established a **DETOUR** down Old Long Beach Road ([CLICK HERE](#) or on the map below for details).

**IMPORTANT:** The new closure & detour will **BEGIN** on **Monday, November 11, 2024** and is expected to **END** by no later than **October 25, 2025**.



While road construction and detours are never enjoyable to commuters or vacation travelers alike, **these improvements are needed**; and will greatly improve traffic flow once complete. During this closure / detour, please remember to plan ahead, and allow a little more time (and patience) when going travelling to and from our great Island!

## **FIRE: Beach Warning Flag Season Ends**

As of last **Friday, November 1**, the National Weather Service has **ENDED** its Beach Warning Flag forecasts for the 2024 Season.

With the exception of isolated extreme weather events, this now means that:

- **Rescue Tubes** have been **REMOVED** from all Water Safety Stations for the Winter season
- **Beach Warning Flags** will **NO LONGER** be physically flown from Town Facilities, the Oak Island Pier, Emergency Response Vehicles, or partner agencies & businesses
- **Beach Warning Lights** will be **TURNED OFF** until forecasting resumes in April 2025
- **Warning Flag Graphics** will **NO LONGER** be updated on the **Beach Information** and **Beach Safety** pages of the Town Website

**WHY DO WE DO THIS?** To put it plainly, the amount of in-water activity during the winter months is so sparse, it simply doesn't justify the cost of personnel and equipment needed to maintain these services on the beach at all times. However, staffing will still be present at the Fire Stations, and we will always be ready to respond to any emergency calls received.

**These services will all RESUME** when forecasting for the 2025 season begins on **Tuesday, April 1, 2024.**

The Town of Oak Island wishes to thank all of the partner agencies, community organizations, local businesses, and concerned residents and property owners who contributed to this year's beach safety efforts by flying Beach Warning Flags and sharing Beach Safety information. This heightened level of community involvement contributed to another successful season.
