## Spruce Pine Donation Delivery

Back on **November 3, 2024** the Town hosted the **BANDING TOGETHER: Relief for Western NC** benefit concert & donation event to help support the Town of Spruce Pine, NC, in their ongoing recovery following Hurricane Helene. The event itself was a huge success, raising \$30,000 in financial contributions, and **delivering an entire truckload of donated supplies.**

While the donated goods were immediately delivered and put to use, Town officials were able to coordinate a personal delivery of the financial contributions just before the Thanksgiving holiday.

## Christmas Tree Drop Off

While for some the Christmas season has just begun, there are many observers who have been looking at their Christmas trees since before their Thanksgiving turkeys were thawed.

Regardless of when their trees were first trimmed, eventually they will all be put away. That's why the [\*\*Public Works Department\*\*](#) is here to help, with the annual "***Grinding of the Greens***" program. This program provides a convenient and environmentally beneficial way to dispose of your live Christmas trees, where after collection they are ground up and used as

mulch in various Town parks and facilities.

Collection will be available beginning on **December 26** in the **Middleton Park Complex** parking lot at 4610 E Dolp Drive. Just look for the designated area with signage.

**REMEMBER:**

- All decorations must be removed from trees before disposal
- DO NOT place trees on the beach or dunes
- DO NOT burn trees as part of beach bonfires
