RFP: Audit Services

The Town of Oak Island invites qualified **independent auditors** to submit proposals for providing **Auditing Services** to the Town.

The audit shall be performed in accordance with the laws and regulations of the State of North Carolina, which include requirements for the minimum scope of the Town's audit. The selected firm will be considered to be an independent contractor and will be wholly responsible for the services and the supervision of its own employees and permitted sub-contractors. The

Town intends to continue the relationship with the auditor for no less than three years on the basis of annual negotiation after the completion of the first-year contract.

Proposals must be submitted by no later than 3:00 PM on February 28, 2025.

New Scam Notice

In last week's edition, we mentioned a series of recent phone scams, where the caller claims to be with the Oak Island Police Department and demanding payment as penalty for a missed court date.

This week, the **Brunswick County Sheriff's Office** has [noted a series of similar phone scams](#). In these cases, fake robo-texts are posing as toll road collection services, claiming you owe unpaid fees and pushing you to click a shady link. ***Don't fall for it!***

Here's how to stay safe:

- Don't click unknown links.
- FasTrak (or any other toll road company) never texts for payments.
- Got a suspicious text? Delete it.
- Clicked the link? Report it at www.ncdoj.gov/complaint or call 1-877-5-NO-SCAM.

We wholeheartedly agree with the Sheriff's Office when they say **scammers never rest!** Please stay alert, and if you or someone you know feel you may be a victim of this latest effort, please report it to the Department of Justice at www.ncdoj.gov/complaint or click the link below.
