





2025 Anticipated (Blue) vs Revenue (Green)








Budget vs Expense (Enc/Req included based on above controls) by Year



The month of February has been limited on events but has been a lot of planning for 2025. We are in transition phase in our Community Resource Officer position, so in the meantime, Administrative Assistant Tickle and myself have been continuing with the program. Officer Joesph Trahey accepted the Community Resource Officer position as of February 24, 2025

February 5, 2025. Meeting with the Recreation Department. Administrative staff met with Recreation Department staff to discuss all of the events that the Recreation Department has on the 2025 Event Schedule and how we can help as a department. After leaving the meeting, we were able to pass along to Chief and the new CRO Trahey the events of the Recreation Department, so we can make a schedule of both departments combined.
