

Here's your opportunity to join an exciting unit with the Town Staff, and help serve residents and visitors to Oak Island within the busiest times of the year. The Town of Oak Island is currently hiring for **Beach Services Patrol** positions for the **2025 Season**.

Beach Services Patrol employees are responsible for enforcing a variety of local ordinances such as dunes enforcement, littering, and leash law violations along the Town's beach strand and issuing citations and warnings as warranted. The employee is subject to the hazards associated with working in an outside coastal environment and in extreme weather conditions. Work is performed under the general supervision of the Fire Department Assistant Chief of Special Operations, and is evaluated through observation, conferences, and reports concerning the quality and effectiveness of incident response, public contact, and code enforcement operations
