CLOSURE NOTICE: Training In Middleton Park Complex on Thursday

PLEASE NOTE: During the **afternoon hours** on **Thursday, April 24, 2025**, the **Middleton Park Complex** will be **CLOSED** to accommodate a **joint training exercise** between Brunswick County EMS and the Oak Island Fire Department.

This training will present as a **Mass Casualty Event**; and primarily focus on emergency medical and triage procedures. This is not a large-scale exercise, and **no street closures or parking lot restrictions are expected**, however several features within the Middleton Park Complex will be **temporarily CLOSED**, including the **Pirate Ship Playground, Amphitheater, and Concert Field**.

The exercise grounds will be marked with fire line tape, and some minor traffic control may be needed. Those in the area are asked to follow any directional signage posted, or traffic control officers present.

To ensure a safe and efficient training for all involved, **please do not approach the exercise area or try to speak with responders onsite**, even if they do not appear to be "active" participants at the moment.

REMINDER: Funding Applications Due Soon

As first reported in last week's edition, the **NEW Outside Agency Funding Applications** for **Fiscal Year 2025 / 2026** are now available, and are **DUEDUE** by close of business on **Monday, May 5, 2025**.

These applications include the updated **Funding Policy**, which serves to promote partnerships between the Town of Oak Island and non-profit agencies for the benefit of Oak Island residents, to equitably and efficiently allocate resources to strengthen agencies, and to provide sound and clear methods for decisions.

Ensuring all tax dollars are used in the best possible manner for the benefit of all citizens is a top priority for the Town of Oak Island. As such, the **Funding Application** requires an **Agency Mission Statement, Key Accomplishments, Goals, Objectives**, and information on the specific program(s) for which the agency is requesting funds and how it aligns with the Town's Strategic Plan.

Brunswick County Free Cleanup Week

For those doing some annual Spring Cleaning, **April 21 - 26** is the **Free Cleanup Week** at the **Brunswick County Landfill**.

Brunswick County property owners and residents can dispose of all materials, except for regular household trash and hazardous waste, free of charge during Free Cleanup Week.

Individuals can dispose of metal, tires, electronics, latex paint, clothing, shoes, used oil, oil filters, antifreeze, gasoline, fluorescent bulbs, used cooking oil, smoke detectors, household batteries, and yard debris in their designated area at the landfill during this week. Participants must show proof of Brunswick County property ownership or residency.

Businesses and commercial vehicles will be charged normal tipping fees. The Brunswick County Solid Waste and Recycling Division hosts two Free Cleanup Week events a year, typically the third full week in April and September.

Leaf Collection Delay Update

In a notice published this past Tuesday, the Public Works Department provided an update on **Yard Debris Collection** service, which is currently operating on a **DELAYED** schedule due to needed mechanical repair on the **Leaf Collection Truck**.

Currently, crews are still working to complete **Collection Zone 3**, where larger than usual loads and ongoing repairs are continuing to slow progress. Work in **Zone 3** is now projected to take the entire week ahead. It is important to note that ALL debris will be removed before proceeding to the next Collection Zone.

Remember that you can help prevent costly equipment repairs and unwanted downtime, by making sure leaf piles in the right-of-way are free of items such as limbs, bricks, rocks, and other debris, which can cause major damages (picture here) to the trucks' operating systems
