
The Oak Island Recreation Department has just announced **three** new opportunities to participate in further development of the **Parks & Recreation Master Plan**.

Mark your calendars now for the next **Community Open House** event as part of the **Charting the Course 2045** project to update the Town's Comprehensive Land Use Plan.

On **Wednesday, June 11, 2025** from **6:00 PM - 8:00 PM**, the Open House will be held in the Council Chambers on the second floor of Town Hall, to review the **DRAFT Comprehensive Land Use Plan**.

Over the past year, valuable input from residents has been gathered, and now it's time to make sure the draft reflects the community's vision and priorities.

This drop-in event will feature summaries of each chapter of the plan, with opportunities to provide feedback, ask questions, and speak directly with the project team. Whether interested in growth, infrastructure, recreation, natural resources, or resilience, everyone's voice is essential in shaping the final plan.

Once the project team incorporates all feedback from this event, a FULL DRAFT of the Comprehensive Plan will be posted for review on the *Charting the Course 2045* webpage. Town Projects Update

Back in early March of this year, the new **Town Projects** page was launched, to provide a basic overview of the details, locations, and current completion status of the Town's large scale building and renovation projects. This page is updated during the first week of every month; with the month of May bringing some particularly welcome updates regarding the ongoing repairs from the **PTC 8** storm last fall.

All **PTC 8** projects received a significant update which included a new Project Schedule, while some other projects were moved into the "Recently Completed" category, such as the Pickleball Court Lighting and the Recreation Center Needs Assessment Study.

Joint Training Review



On Tuesday of last week, the Town's **Drone Unit** participated in a joint training exercise conducted by the **U.S. Coast Guard Station Oak Island**. As seen here in this week's cover photo, this exercise presented as a full-scale active shooter scenario, which took place on the Bald Head Island Ferry, and utilized several local law enforcement agencies, as well as other state and federal partners.

As it would in a real-world response, the Drone Unit provided critical aerial reconnaissance and situational awareness for all participants.

Just like how the drone was used to help to coordinate the exercise's "moving parts" – training like this is crucial to helping bring those many parts together, to learn how to work as a team in times of crisis.

The Town is honored to have the Drone Unit participate in such an important exercise, and is grateful for our partner organizations who help to support and protect our community and region!
