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Recreation Master Plan Survey **EXTENDED**

Last week, the Oak Island Recreation Department had planned to launch a series of **three** new Public Input Sessions, to receive feedback in development of the **Parks & Recreation Master Plan**. Unfortunately, due to an emergency cancellation by Plan's development consultant, those meetings have been **POSTPONED until further notice**.

While staff is working to reschedule these **Public Input Meetings as soon as possible**, the Town is extending the opportunity to provide virtual input through the **Parks & Recreation Master Plan Survey**!



Originally scheduled to close this week, **the survey will now remain open until Saturday, May 31 at 5:00 PM.**

This is a thorough, comprehensive review of the recreation facilities, programs, and services offered by the Town of Oak Island. It only takes about 15 - 20 minutes to complete, and provides multiple opportunities for feedback on current programs, as well as suggestion for new services and facility expansion.

Burn Ban LIFTED

NOTICE: The **Burn Ban** in enacted by the Town of Oak Island on **Saturday, May 3** was **LIFTED** shortly after **NOON** on **Monday, May 12**.

This action coincided with the Brunswick County Fire Marshal's Office lifting the Brunswick County Burn Ban at NOON on the same day.

The multiple Burn Bans were initially enacted in response to unfavorable weather conditions for open burning, as well as efforts by multiple agencies to combat a wildfire affecting the surrounding areas near the City of Boiling Spring Lakes.
