Budget Public Hearing

The Oak Island Town Council will hold a ***Special Meeting*** on **Tuesday, May 27, 2025**, at **6:00 PM** in Council Chambers, located on the second floor of Town Hall at 4601 E Oak Island Drive. THIS WEEK: Traffic Change on SE 47th St.

As first noted in [last week's edition](#), **SE 47th St.** will change to a **one-way traffic pattern** later this week.



Starting on **Saturday, May 31**, traffic will only be able to turn onto SE 47th St. from E. Oak Island Drive, but must use SE 46th St. to exit the Town Hall parking lot. This change will provide a more efficient traffic flow, and help increase pedestrian safety.

Additionally, the **mailbox** located in the gravel parking lot beside the Public Services Building **will be relocated** to directly behind the Town Hall, as noted in the graphic above. This will provide a singular flow for depositing mail, coming in from SE 47th St. and exiting out onto SE 46th St.

Water Quality Report Now Available



The report presents the data gathered from the Sample & Testing Period of **January 1 - December 31, 2024**, as part of the **NC Source Water Assessment Program** (SWAP). The Report provides information about water quality and the services delivered by the **Water Division**, showcasing the efforts they take to continually protect and improve water distribution and resources.

The Town's primary water source is purchased from Brunswick County utilizing the Castle Hayne Aquifer, through 14 wells approximately 175 ft. deep. The Town also has a secondary source from N.E. Cape Fear River above lock and dam #1 at Kings Bluff Pumping Station, in addition to two emergency back-up wells that pump from the Pee Dee Aquifer.

Beach Safety Unit Training

Earlier this year, the Town combined the previously separate Beach Services Unit and Ocean Rescue Units, merging them into the new **Beach Safety Unit** under the Fire Department. Last week, we wrapped up the Ocean Rescue training with all team members, with the Beach Services team later joining in training as well.



These 12 new members will team up with the 5 supervisory members, along with other Fire Department members that have also completed the training. Together, this will allow the Beach Safety Unit to provide **on-beach patrols** from **6:00 AM - 6:00 PM - 7 days a week** when coupled with the Beach Services Division!
