Nuclear Plant Siren Test

(Contributed by Duke Energy)

The outdoor warning sirens around the **Brunswick Nuclear Plant** will be **TESTED** between **10:00 AM and 11:00 AM** on **Wednesday, July 9, 2025**.

The 38 sirens within 10 miles of the Brunswick Nuclear Plant will sound at **full-volume for five to 30 seconds**. To ensure they are functioning properly, it may be necessary to test some sirens more than once. Follow-up testing after siren maintenance may be required after 11 a.m.

Testing is performed in cooperation with emergency management officials in Brunswick and New Hanover counties, who are responsible for sounding the sirens.

Because this is a test, local broadcasting stations will not interrupt regular programming to broadcast Emergency Alert System (EAS) messages. If there was ever a real emergency at the plant requiring the sirens to be sounded, local radio and television stations would broadcast information and instructions to the public.

Bicycle Plan Open House

On **Wednesday, July 30, 2025** from **5:00 PM - 7:00 PM**, the Town will be hosting a **Public Open House** event in the Council Chambers, to gather community input on proposed projects for the **Oak Island Bicycle Plan**.



First announced in the [June 2 edition](#), the ***Oak Island Bicycle Plan*** will work to identify priority bicycle infrastructure projects to improve bicycle safety, access, and connectivity across the Town of Oak Island. The Plan document will also recommend accompanying policies and programs as well as implementation steps to support and move the projects forward. The upcoming Open House event will also provide an opportunity to review input from the recently completed [Public Survey](#), which ran throughout the entire month of June.

REMINDER: Survey Work Begins

Reminder that starting **this week**, the **Summer Beach Survey** work will begin as part of the upcoming **Beach Nourishment Project**.



Surveying contractor **TI Coastal Services** will be conducting survey operations on both **land** in a pickup truck on the beach areas, and in **water** using small boat like the one pictured below.



The survey boat will be clearly marked and may come close to shore during this process. **This is normal and not cause for alarm**; however, those fishing or swimming near the boat are asked to temporarily reel in their lines or move until the boat passes.

Dune Pathway Safety Notice

Recently, Town Staff in the Development Services Department have been notified of potential hazards when privately accessing the public beach areas. Due to **shelf erosion** and other factors, some of the private **Shared Access Pathways** have developed significant drop-offs on the beach side, as pictured below.



While some of these pathways may be restored by the upcoming **B2025 / 26 Beach Nourishment Project** mentioned in the article above, the currently damaged or incomplete pathways can be dangerous, as well as contribute to additional damage.



It is important to note, pathways that do not fully and safely connect to the beach should NOT be used! Broken, damaged, or incomplete pathways should be reported to the property owner or property management agency as soon as they are discovered.
