# Oak Island Awarded NCDEQ Grant

On **Thursday, July 24**, the North Carolina Department of Environmental Quality (NCDEQ) [issued a media release](#) announcing nearly \$6 million in coastal resiliency grants to 32 communities for planning, engineering, design, and construction.

The Town of Oak Island is one of the grant recipients, and will be awarded **\$70,000** as part of the [NC Resilient Coastal Communities Program](#) (RCCP). The Town does not receive funds directly, but rather NCDEQ directly pays a consultant to complete the Program's **Phase 1 & 2**. The consultant selected by DEQ is [Colliers Engineering and Design](#), based in Holmdel, NJ.

The main deliverable for Phases 1 & 2 is a Resilience Strategy, which includes a Project Portfolio of projects that address the community's specific coastal resilience needs. The Resilience Strategy provides a strong foundation that can later inform a full Resilience Plan or be integrated into existing local plans and ordinances. Having a document like this helps communities clarify their goals, attract funding, and pave a more direct path to implementation.

Once Phase 1 & 2 are complete, the Town can then apply for future funding through RCCP for engineering and design (Phase 3) and implementation (Phase 4) for projects identified in our Project Portfolio.

## **Hazard Mitigation Public Input Meeting**

Last month **June 19, 2025** a kickoff meeting was held for the **2025 Update** to the **Southeastern NC Regional Hazard Mitigation Plan** (RHMP). Following up on this, the RHMP Planning Committee has scheduled the first **Public Input Meeting** for **Monday, August 18, 2025** from **6:00 PM - 7:00 PM**.

This **virtual** meeting will provide an online opportunity to learn more about the Plan Update, and provide important feedback to help shape the process. Last updated in 2021, updating the RHMP will help ensure all applicable counties and their municipalities remain eligible for various forms of federal pre-disaster and post-disaster hazard mitigation funding.

## New AED Notice

This past **Friday, July 25**, the Town of Oak Island received the donation of a new **Avive Connect AED**, which has now been installed on the pumphouse beside the **Oak Island Splashpad** in the Middleton Park Complex.



This new automated external defibrillator (AED) is one of **TWO units** donated by the **Oak Island Friends of Parks Foundation**. While the unit at the pumphouse joins AED equipment recently installed in other areas of the Middleton Park Complex, the second donated Avive AED will see a much "higher calling" -- as its compact size makes it perfect for ***aerial drone delivery***. The **Town's Drone Unit** has already tested the AED and placed it into service. The Fire Department and the Town of Oak Island sincerely thank the volunteers and donors of the Friend of Parks Foundation for this considerable donation to help improve public health.

The foundation is a 501 (c)(3) public charity, which is separate from the Town. Through events, auctions and donations, they raise funds to purchase items tangible with the goal of enhancing the Oak Island parks experience for everyone. # Heat Safety Reminders



An **Excessive Heat Warning** remains in effect, along with **Heat Advisories** for much of the week ahead, with heat indices of **105°F** or greater forecast. **HEAT is the #1 weather-related cause of death in the United States!**

Whether on the beach or outdoors in general, it will be important to heed the NWS warnings, and **remember to:**

- **Drink plenty of water, and avoid beverages with alcohol**
- **Apply SPF 30 or higher sunscreen every two hours**
- **Wear lightweight, light-colored, and loose-fitting clothing**
- **Stay in the shade as much as possible**
- **Keep PETS and SMALL CHILDREN off the sand during the heat of the day.**

**IMPORTANT:** If you or someone around you begins to show signs of **Heat Stroke**, including **throbbing headache; confusion; slurred speech**, and **rapid, strong pulse**, **call 9-1-1 immediately**, and follow the instructions provided by the telecommunicator.

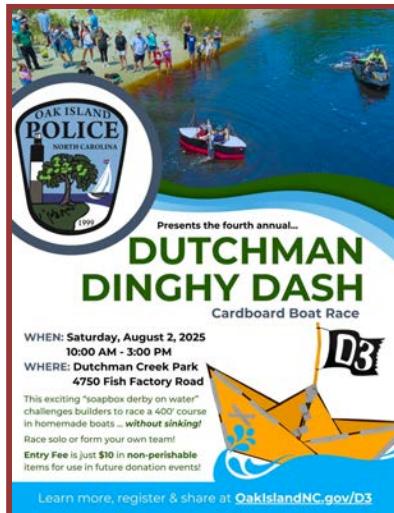
