PUBLIC HEARING: Land Use Plan

During the Town Council meeting this week, the Council will conduct a ***Public Hearing*** to review the updated ***Coastal Area Management Act (CAMA) Land Use Plan***, as presented on the [***2045 Charting the Course***](#) update page.

All interested citizens are encouraged to attend. **Each speaker will be allotted three minutes.** Written comments may be submitted during or following the hearing to the Town Clerk at [***lstites@oakislandnc.gov***](mailto:lstites@oakislandnc.gov).

Following the public hearing, the Town Council will consider adoption of the Land Use Plan. Once adopted, the plan will be submitted to the Director of the North Carolina Division of Coastal Management for certification. Written objections, comments, or statements of support shall be submitted to the Division of Coastal Management's District Planner, Mike Christenbury, 127 Cardinal Drive Extension, Wilmington, NC 28405, no more than 30 calendar days after local adoption of the plan. "Closing The Loop" on Misinformation

"Hey, whatever happened in that situation?"

"Did the Town ever say how that ended?"

"No follow up notice was published, they must be hiding something!"

Questions and comments like these are ones we see often in the **Police & Fire Departments**. In a world of **instant communication**, mixed with social media ***misinformation***, it can be hard for the truth to keep up with a good story!

Overall, Oak Island is one of the state's safest communities to live, work, and enjoy, but that doesn't mean emergencies, crimes, and other serious incidents don't happen. **When they do occur**, we begin **immediate** contact through our **Communications Office**, to keep **you informed** on ANY possible impacts to personal safety, property security, or travel safety.

Whether it's a total loss house fire, or even an unattended death, these responses often involve ***very complex***, but ***very thorough*** investigations. While social media can condition us to expect answers immediately (and assume darker motives when those answers aren't provided), the **truth** is often that investigations ... or rather ***good investigations***, take time.

We understand the need for closure, and the importance it provides in your sense of security. That's why we work hard to ***"Close The Loop"*** and provide regular updates on important topics of community interest. While you WON'T find us discussing every case detail in your favorite social media group, you WILL receive important email notifications and emergency text alerts through the ***OKInformation*** system. **IMPORTANT:** Once an **immediate safety concern has passed**, any ongoing updates will be provided on the same notice posted in the ***OKInformation*** page at **OakIslandNC.gov/NEWS**.

So remember the next time you see a claim that doesn't seem verified, YOU can help dispel misinformation, by checking for the latest updates!
