## Duke Energy Siren Test THIS WEEK

The **outdoor warning sirens** around the **Brunswick Nuclear Plant** will be **tested** between **10:00 AM** and **11:00 AM** on **Wednesday, October 8, 2025**.

The 38 sirens within 10 miles of the Brunswick Nuclear Plant will sound at full-volume for five to 30 seconds. To ensure they are functioning properly, it may be necessary to test some sirens more than once. Follow-up testing after siren maintenance may be required after 11:00 AM.

Testing is performed in cooperation with emergency officials in Brunswick and New Hanover counties, who are responsible for sounding the sirens.

Because this is a test, local broadcasting stations will not interrupt regular programming to broadcast Emergency Alert System (EAS) messages. If there was ever a real emergency at the plant requiring the sirens to be sounded, local radio and television stations would broadcast information and instructions to the public.



## CoastWise Initiative Now Open

During the **July 8, 2025** Oak Island Town Council heard a proposal from the **UNCW College of Science & Engineering** (UNCW) for a **three-year** project to evaluate living shoreline approaches at multiple Oak Island sites.

What began as a proposal for a joint study quickly grew into a full partnership, providing multiple other opportunities for both the Town and UNCW. The Memorandum of Understanding approved by the Town Council to establish this partnership, has since been branded as the new ***CoastWise Initiative***.



This partnership will be mutually beneficial, as it utilizes the knowledge and resources of UNCW to benefit the Town's natural environment, while at the same time providing valuable spaces for students and staff to research, study, and contribute to the ecology of marine habitats.

In addition to the ***Living Shoreline Project*** (now scheduled to launch in ***Spring of 2026***), as the ***CoastWise Initiative*** grows and develops, new projects will be added, further enhancing the natural benefits to the Town and the educational resources to the University.

# Kayak Launch CLOSED



Last week, the **Tidalwaves Kayak & Canoe Launch** located on the Davis Canal, near the Recreation Center at **SE Street** was **CLOSED** due to damage from weathering and significant deterioration over time.



The **GOOD NEWS** however is that this ramp will now be replaced, thanks to a **Public Access Grant** of **\$32,000** from the **North Carolina Coastal Management Program**. The Grant was procured thanks to the hard work of the Town's **Development Services Department**, and was awarded in early September. It will be administered through the NC Division of Coastal Management and the NC Department of Environmental Quality.

Grant funds will provide for installation of an all-new, fully ADA compliant Kayak Launch, consisting of 3ft. x 12ft. launch, a 4ft. x 12ft. open slip, an ADA transfer platform, and a new aluminum gangway.

The funds have just been released as of this week, and the Public Works Department has immediately begun working with the project engineer to establish a construction timeline. Once building starts and a completion date is determined, updates will be made available on the **Town Projects** page. While she more than achieved her goal of gaining experience in an emergency setting, she’s also made great friends throughout this Summer, and has been reminded of her love for the ocean! ## Be The Helper: "Muting Misinformation"

In regards to **Public Safety** and emergency response, 2025 has proven to be a quite busy year. One growing concern for first responders in recent months is the amount of ***misinformation*** being shared online and in social media.

This week, we offer the **important reminder** to "***Be The Helper in 'Muting Misinformation!'***"

The modern climate of social media has given us all an expectation of "immediate updates" and unlimited information. That's why it's more important than ever to **ensure the information you see is from a valid source** before believing, or especially sharing such posts.

While you may think you are helping your neighbors and community to stay informed, in reality, **sharing misinformation can be dangerous**. Those same neighbors you are trying to help could be making decisions based on what you've shared which could put them in jeopardy. Likewise, this can also drain the resources of local law enforcement when they have to spend needless hours verifying claims made on social media.

So remember to ***Be The Helper*** -- make sure you're watching and sharing only the **FACTS** and **VERIFIED** information. As always, the Town of Oak Island, our Public Safety departments, and Communications Office maintain the highest commitment to providing the ***correct information***, at the ***correct time***, so that you can make the ***correct decisions*** for your personal safety.

**REMEMBER: If at any point, an immediate threat to Town residents is perceived, Email and Emergency Text Alerts will be sent through the Town's *OKInformation* system!**


