Beach Nourishment Project Begins

It's been several years in the making, but on-location work for the **2025 / 2026 Beach Nourishment Project** will officially begin ***THIS WEEK!***



NOTICE: Starting on **Friday, November 14, 2025** the public parking area and Beach Access Locations on **SE 49th St.** will be **CLOSED** until further notice, to allow for equipment placement and project staging

Additionally, as of this week, a surveyor from **Weeks Marine** (the contractor performing the dredging and sand placement) will begin performing the **Before Dredging (BD)** surveys along the beach. Both the **BD** and **AD (After Dredging)** Surveys will be performed regularly throughout the project and will begin at the eastern edge of the work area near SE 46th St. and move towards the West as the work progresses.

Sidewalk Project Moving Forward

Last month, the Town Council approved the contracting services needed to begin **Phase I** of the **Commercial Area Sidewalk Improvement Project**. This project will add **NEW** sidewalk along more than half a mile of **E Oak Island Drive**, from NE 46th St. to NE 56th St. Most importantly, this will also accommodate the future **installation of Pedestrian Crosswalks**.



PROJECT UPDATE: Starting this week, **survey work** will begin to establish and mark the project's construction area. All the survey work should be conducted within the Right-Of-Way (ROW) and should not affect vehicle or roadway traffic.

Additionally, the contractor who will be performing the new sidewalk installation, Morgan Trucking and General Construction Inc., is anticipating to begin staging equipment and materials by as early as next week (November 17). Currently the project timeline remains on schedule, with a completion tentatively expected by the early Spring of 2026.

Water Disinfectant Change Notice

In October, the Brunswick County Public Utilities Department began its **Annual Disinfection Changeover & Flushing Program**. During the past month, Public Utilities crews have worked to flush water mains and distribute chlorine throughout the County system.

NOTICE: As of this past **Saturday, November 8**, Brunswick County has **converted back** to using Chloramines as the primary disinfectant. Hydrant Flushing will continue throughout the rest of the month of November.

During this transition period of changing the primary disinfection agent back to chloramines, customers may experience a brief period when there may be a noticeable change in the taste or smell of the water. This is a normal part of the process and water is safe to use. Depending on your location within the distribution system and usage patterns, it could be two to three weeks for your drinking water to transition from free chlorine to combined chlorine. If taste and/or odor problems persist, please contact the Brunswick County Public Utilities Department.
