The lights are up and the tree has been trimmed! ***THIS WEEKEND*** brings some of the most festive fun of the year for Oak Island! Here's a quick rundown of the ***Christmas By the Sea*** activities for the weekend ahead:

- **TREE LIGHTING**: On **Friday, December 5** at **5:00 PM** in the Middleton Park Complex, the Town's annual Christmas Tree Lighting event will include train rides, live entertainment, craft stations, letters to Santa, and even a visit from the Big Guy himself!
- **BREAKFAST WITH SANTA**: (**Registration FULL** - waitlist available) Following his appearance at the Tree Lighting, Santa will build up quite an appetite! On **Saturday, December 6** at **8:00 AM**, join Santa at the **Oak Island Community Center** for a hearty breakfast for only **\$10** for Town Residents (\$12 Non-Residents). - **PARADE**: Following breakfast, Santa will take a stride down E Oak Island Drive as the featured entry in the ***Christmas By The Sea Parade***. Starting at **2:00 PM** on **Saturday, December 6**, the Parade will begin in front of Town Hall at SE 46th St. and proceed all the way down the McGlamery St.
- **HOLIDAY MARKET**: On **Sunday, December 7** from **NOON - 4:00 PM** in the Middleton Park Complex, Oak Island brings holiday shopping opportunities directly to coastal residents! Visit with area vendors as they offer a one-of-a-kind shopping experience, complete with locally made and grown gift opportunities just in time for the holidays!

Beach Nourishment Update

The **2025 / 2026 Beach Nourishment Project** has now entered its second full week of operations, and progress continues to move on schedule for the Town's **largest non-emergency beach nourishment** operation in **25 years!** Over the holiday break last week, Assistant Town Manager Kent Jackson (pictured below) toured the construction areas, and was given a full onsite briefing now that regular operations are underway.



As of **Monday, December 1** Dredging & Sand Placement has been **COMPLETED** from **SE 43rd St.** to **29th Pl E**. Operations are currently in the area between **29th Pl E** and **19th Pl E**, working to move WEST.

As a reminder, operations are conducted **24 hours per day** and include **noise, moving machinery, ground vibrations**, and **closed beach areas**. To ensure the safety of everyone, please be sure to **respect the boundaries of any closed staging or construction areas**, and **do not distract crews onsite by attempting to speak with them or ask questions**.

SAFETY BRIEF



Help Prevent "Porch Pirates"

Living on the coast, we're all familiar with ***PIRATES***. This holiday season however, the **Police Department** reminds everyone to ***keep pirates in the past & off of your porch!***




With a majority of shoppers now buying at least some of their holiday gifts online, here are some helpful reminders to help prevent "porch pirates" from swiping your seasonal gifts:

- **USE the “Specific Instructions” option.** Many online retailers allow you to add specific instructions on where and how to leave packages. Use this feature to let couriers know a more secure or hidden location to leave packages.
- **REQUIRE a signature.** If you can schedule a time to be home when your packages arrive, that’s great! However, there may also be contact-free ways to sign through most delivery services. Adding the “signature required” and “delivery confirmation” options are great tools if available.
- **INSTALL motion activated lights.** Even though it's getting darker earlier, delivery drivers are still working well into the night. Simple, inexpensive, outdoor lighting with motion sensors can be a big deterrent to thieves.
- **CONSIDER adding a doorbell camera.** These don’t have to be expensive units - you can even repurpose an old smartphone! Their main goal is to have a clear, high quality view of your delivery area when you're away. This is much easier to do if you’re following the “Special instructions” tip above, and designating a safe space for deliveries.

FINALLY, remember to simply ***be a good neighbor***. The holidays can be a stressful time, and delivery drivers are human too. Mistakes happen! With streets named by number AND direction here in Oak Island, we often see packages delivered to the wrong house (ex: a “NE” address instead of “NW” street, etc.). Taking a few minutes to make sure an incorrectly delivered package gets to the right home, could make all the difference in someone else’s holiday. Even “Santa’s Helpers” need a little help sometimes!
