Resident Parking Permits Now Available

This week enters the middle of January, and that means the **April 1** start of **Paid Parking Season** is **less than two months away**. Recently, the Town Hall Customer Service Staff and the Town's contracted Parking Services vendor [Otto Connect](http://OttoConnect.com) have been receiving calls asking when the Parking Permits will become available for purchase.

As of last week, the **RESIDENT PARKING PERMITS** are **now available to purchase** through either the [SurfCAST](http://SurfCAST.com) mobile app, online at surfcast.ottoconnect.us/pay, or by calling Otto Connect directly at **910-200-1497**. As in previous years, residents and property owners may purchase up to three (3) Permits total, at a cost of \$10 per Permit.

For non-residents, an opening purchase date has not yet been determined for the **SEASONAL PARKING PERMITS** and the **BULK PARKING PERMITS**, though they will go on sale sometime before the start of the season on April 1. **NOTE:** Hourly, Daily, and Weekly Permits are NOT available in advance, as they become active immediately upon purchase. Once a

purchase date for Seasonal and Bulk Permits has been established, it will be announced on the **Parking Information** page of the Town Website. [UPDATE EDIT • January 14: Seasonal and Bulk Parking Permits are now expected to be  on sale beginning on Sunday, February 15, 2026 unless otherwise noted]

Citizens Academy Reminder

Last week brought one of the most anticipated announcements of the new year, the **2026 Oak Island Citizens Academy** is now **accepting applications!**



This interactive program, designed to educate and familiarize residents with the departments and services provided by their local government, now features **TEN (10) individual classes**, held on **Tuesdays & Thursdays** in the months of **February and March** (unless otherwise noted).

Through hands-on class learning and "field trip" demonstrations, this course helps to provide a deeper understanding of the **"who, why, & how"** government operates at the municipal level. The program also serves to encourage stronger participation in local government, from residents of all interests.

Sidewalk Project Nearing Completion



It's one of the most common **New Year's Resolutions**, to get out and **do more walking**. Well now the Town of Oak Island is just a few "steps" away from helping to make that resolution safer and more accessible.

Phase I of the **Commercial Area Sidewalk Improvement Project** is quickly nearing to a close, as the installation of more than **1,700 linear feet** of **NEW sidewalk** has now been completed along E Oak Island Drive.



Installed on the north side of E Oak Island Drive from NE 46th St. to NE 56th St., this project provides more than half a mile of new sidewalk in one of the busiest portions of Town. Most importantly, this new sidewalk also accommodates the future installation of **Pedestrian Crosswalks**, as NCDOT requires sidewalk on both sides of a street before crosswalks can be installed.

At current pace, the sidewalk installation is expected to be completed by the end of January. Immediately after completion, contractor Morgan Trucking and General Construction Inc., will begin installation of the NCDOT approved **Pedestrian Crosswalk** and lighted crossing signal at the intersection of E Oak Island Dr. and NE 51st St.

Beach Nourishment Progress

REMINDER: The 2025 / 2026 Beach Nourishment Project is now active in multiple work zones, as sand placement for the Wilmington Harbor and the Oak Island Off-Shore (OS-OKI) projects are both in operation on the public beach areas.



Both of these operations are reflected in the **Progress Updates & Map** map provided on the **Beach Nourishment Project** page. Over the next week, the Wilmington Harbor Project is anticipated to be in the area of the **Oak Island Pier**, while the OK-OKI Project will be working in the area of **51st Pl W**.

This means that machinery and equipment, as well as closed beach areas and Beach Access Locations will be seen in several locations. To ensure the **safety of everyone**, please **respect the boundaries** of all **closed areas**, and **DO NOT** distract crews onsite by attempting to speak with them or ask them questions.

SCAM ALERT: Email Invoices

The Town of Oak Island Development Services and the Oak Island Police Department have been made aware of a **new scam attempt** targeting residents and property owners. In this latest effort, scammers are using publicly available information skimmed from Zoning Applications and Public Hearing Notices, to generate **FAKE Permit Approval** emails, which demand **payment of included invoices**. The emails claim the invoices **must be paid** in order to proceed with any permit approvals and authorizations.



THESE ARE A SCAM! While the Town can send invoices, in most cases they are not charged until a permit is ready to be issued. Any official invoice sent by the Town will include an ***Invoice Number***, which can be used to verify charges when speaking with a Permit Specialist.

These can seem like legitimate emails at first, using real permit numbers and the names of real Town employees, however some deeper reading often reveals the telltale signs of a scam, such as:

- The email does **NOT** come from an **official Town email** address ending in “**@oakislandnc.gov**” (ex: ***TownofLeicesterPlanningCommission@usa.com***).
- The email uses an “official sounding” but fictional Board or Committee name (ex: the ***Oak Island Planning Commission*** - *Oak Island has a Planning Board, not a Commission*).
- The email creates a “high-pressure” environment, demanding payment **before** services can be provided.

Remember, regardless of the claim, the purpose of scams are always the same: **to pressure you into giving away your money or personal information!**

Don't be fooled by this latest attempt or any other scam effort. Always be sure to:

- **Check the source email** and verify that it is legitimate.
- **Never click on ANY link** or download attachments, unless they are ones you are expecting
- **DO NOT forward any suspicious links** to friends, family, or co-workers

Finally, if you receive something that is unexpected, or just doesn't “feel right” you can always verify it directly with Town Staff, through the contact information found on the ***Contact Us*** page of the Town Website at **OakIslandNC.gov/CONTACT**.
