



RE : CROSS-CONNECTION CONTROL PROGRAM ANNUAL TESTING NOTICE

Dear Customer

According to our records, it is time to have your Backflow Prevention Device tested. It is important that this test be completed so that we ensure the safety of the water system. This test is required by the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources. Your Backflow Prevention Device is installed on your water service or within your plumbing system. You may have your Backflow Prevention Device tested by a Certified Backflow tester and have the results returned to the Towns Backflow Technician (ORC) within 45 days of this letter or the Town will provide annual testing for your Backflow assembly within 45 days if we have not received your test certification, Town will proceed to have it tested and you will be charged a fee of \$35.00 on your subsequent water bill. A list of Certified Backflow testers are on the Towns Website. Please ensure that the device is accessible and has not been disconnected.

Nothing further is required on your part if your Backflow Prevention Device passes the test. If the Backflow Prevention device fails the test, we will send you the results so you can get the Device repaired or replaced. Once any necessary repairs have been made the device must be retested and the Backflow Device repair report returned to the Public Utilities Department (Backflow).

PLEASE check in the box if you want us to test it or you will have it Tested yourself and return this letter back to the town within 14 days
